Dear Community Leader/Business Owner,

My name is Oscar Guzman, and I have been the director of the Cedartown Performing Arts Center since January 2016. During this time, I have coordinated endlessly with the Cedartown Civic Arts Commission towards a common goal of improving and delivering arts and entertainment to our community. As a small 501(c)3 non-profit organization we struggle to obtain adequate funding to support these ventures, and so we reach out to our community for our Children's Enrichment Summer Camp.

The Children's Enrichment Summer Camp was started with the goal of exposing children to theatre, art, and music for ten days during the summer. This program has allowed children the opportunity to be exposed to a creative world that helps teach life-long skills/passions and talents including singing, acting, communication skills, public speaking, and artistry.

To make this camp available to most in our community, we set a price of \$150 for the ten-day camp which includes teachings, supplies, materials, costumes, tee-shirt, snacks, and lunch. We selected a low price because the cost of child-care is often a deciding factor, especially during the summer, for those with low-income. We also started a needs-based scholarship program so that we never deny any child of this incredible experience.

Today, as our camp opens registration for the *ninth* year, we ask that you consider making a charitable contribution to our efforts so that we may continue to offer this camp at its current price level. Your donation would allow us to continue to provide that same low cost for campers, even through these inflated economic conditions.
